Dear Parent(s) Guardian(s):

The school administration has charged _____ with gross misconduct or disobedience and has decided to issue him/her an out of school suspension of _____ days.

This action has been taken pursuant to Section 10-22.6 of the Illinois School Code, the Policies and Procedures of Lincoln Elementary School Code, the Policies and Procedures of Lincoln Elementary School District 156, and the "Lincoln Elementary School Student-Parent Handbook."

You have the right to request review of the suspension. The review shall be conducted either by the School Board or by a hearing officer appointed by the Board. Requests for a review should be submitted within ten (10) days after the receipt of this letter. At the review, you may appear to discuss the suspension with Board or its hearing officer, and you may be represented by an attorney. You will be responsible for any fees charged by an attorney you retain. After presentation of the evidence or receipt of the hearing officer's report, the Board shall take such action as it finds appropriate.
